What is Graduates into Health (GiH)?

- The GiH programme links students and graduates from Universities to managers who are recruiting to non-clinical entry level roles.
- With a 93% retention rate of graduates staying in roles once recruited
- We have 850+ students already on our pool!

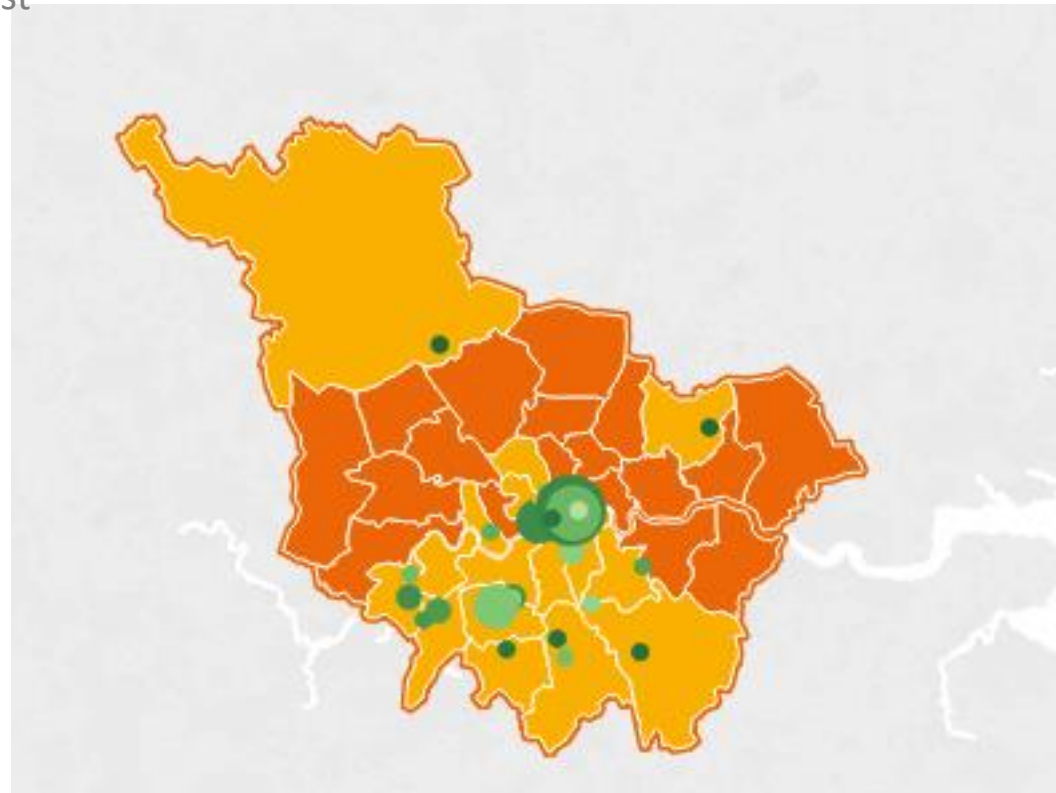


Figure 1: GiH placements

- Paid roles at the minimum of £16,800 per annum plus inner/outer London Weighting

Frequently Asked Questions...

- **I am an International Student, can I still apply for your programme?**
 - If you are currently a student with a student visa and the right to work in the UK then yes!
 - Unfortunately if you have graduated and no longer have a visa you will not be eligible for this programme as our government ensures we recruit from UK and EU residents in the first instances so the only visas they will issue are on skills shortage list; please see the following link:

- **Do you do clinical roles?**
 - Unfortunately no! Our programme is based on only the business function roles in the NHS, these include: Marketing, IT, Finance, Admin, Business Support, Project Work and more...
- **Do you do short term placements?**
 - Yes! Our roles vary from short term contracts to 3 months, 1 year and even sandwich placements!
- **Do you do summer placements?**
 - Our vacancies are of an “as and when” basis, we advertise roles as they become available and therefore cannot guarantee seasonal vacancies
